An exhibition of work by participants in the 13th French language week, from 26 June to 15 July 2008, at the *Alliance Française* gallery, admission free.

As part of the French language week, organised by the *Délégation Générale à la Langue Française et aux Langues de France* (General delegation for French and languages of France) from 14 to 24 March, the CNES *Observatoire de l'Espace* is offering the general public four events to show how, through words, literature, art and its innumerable means of expression, Space inspires the creativity of the French-speaking world.

There will be four original cultural events: an evening during which the fourth edition of the review *Espace(s)* will be presented, two encounters at the *Salon du Livre* and creative workshops entitled "Space diaries".

These actions, which decline Space in many different fields, are CNES' way of sharing its cultural vision of space with different publics - particularly those who are interested in all forms of art, who care greatly about literature, in short, French-speaking people all over the world.
